Position Summary

Under the direction of the Fire Department command staff, a Firefighter/Paramedic responds to fire related alarms and other calls for service, participates in proactive non-emergency community risk reduction activities, training, station work, and equipment maintenance activities. Furthermore, the position will respond to medical emergencies and provide pre-hospital care to victims of injury or illness. The Firefighter/Paramedic is ordinarily the highest medical authority at an emergency medical scene and as such, makes medical decisions based on standing orders, protocols, and orders from on-line and off-line medical direction.

Additionally, the following certifications are desired at time of hire/offer or within the specified time frame after hire:

- A high school diploma or the equivalent (GED).
- A valid Class D or above driver's license - State of WI within 30 days of appointment.
- Certified in WI as a Firefighter Level I (or within one year)
- Certified in WI Driver/Operator Pumper (or within one year)
- Licensed in WI as an EMT- and EMT Paramedic within 18 months
- Certified as a Fire Inspector.
- Certified in WI Driver/Operator Aerial (or within 18 months)
- Valid CPAT Certificate (within 6 months)
